Some of you have blessed us with home cooked breakfast treats and fresh lunches to nourish us in a healthy manner. A YUMMY THANK YOU!

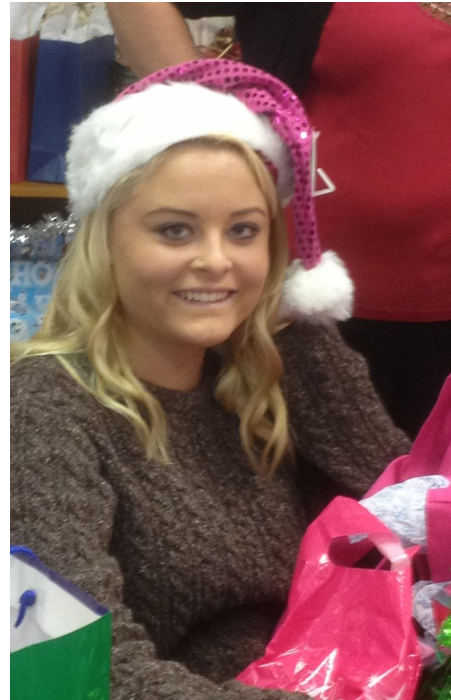
A few of you have often treated the teachers to an unexpected lunch from a favorite restaurant which is always a nice surprise! A RELAXING LUNCH THANK YOU!!
